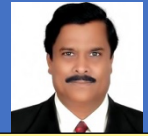

GOD'S REWARDS 2

Genesis 26 12 says

Isaac planted crops in that land and the same year reaped a hundredfold, because the LORD blessed him.

Matthew 7 7 says

"Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.

Matthew 6 6 says

But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen.

Proverbs 11 18 says

Colossians 1 6 says

which is come unto you; even as it is also in all the world bearing fruit and increasing,

as it doth in you also, since the day ye heard and knew the grace of God in truth;

First Corinthians 9 16 to 18 we read

For when I preach the gospel, I cannot boast, since I am compelled to preach.

Woe to me if I do not preach the gospel!

If I preach voluntarily, I have a reward; if not voluntarily, I am simply discharging the trust committed to me.
